INTRODUCTION

This listing provides members of the New Zealand Radio DX League and New Zealand DX Radio Association with a common basis for recognition of "radio countries". Whether one DX's the Amateur Bands, Broadcast, Shortwave or Utility stations, the listing is common for all interests.

The "RADIO COUNTRIES LIST" is largely based on criteria established by the American Radio Relay League, and developed by the New Zealand DX Radio Association in 1982. We are grateful to members of NZDXRA, NZRDXL and former Australian hobby groups Southern Cross DX Club and DX Australia who participated in the process of agreement on a common list. Radio countries have always been a contentious issue in hobby circles and we particularly thank those clubs and long-time DXers who have set aside their previous club lists and personal preferences in the interest of finding common ground amongst the participating clubs.

Countries are firstly listed by continental grouping with explanatory comments, then in alphabetical order.

COUNTRY DETERMINATION RULES

- An area by reason of Government constitutes a separate country.
- An island or group of islands, not having its own Government is considered as a separate country under the following rules:
 - (a) Islands situated off-shore from their governing area must be geographically separated by a minimum of 360km of open water. This point is concerned with islands off-shore from the mainland only.
 - (b) Islands forming part of an island group or which are geographically located adjacent to an island, or island group, which have a common Government, will be considered as separate countries provided there is at least 800km of open water separation between the two areas in question.
- 3. Areas progressing from Colony, Dependency or State to Independence with a change in name shall constitute a new country.
- 4. Areas progressing as in Rule 3, but without a name change, shall also count as a new country.
- 5. Divided countries those with 2 Governments (eg North and South Korea), shall count as 2 countries.
- 6. Should countries covered by Rule 5 reform into one unit, then a new country will be recognised.
- 7. A change in a country's name, without change in that country's status, will also be recognised as a new country.
- 8. Any other special case, that will from time to time be recommended through the NZ Radio DX League Administration Committee and the NZ DX Radio Association, and ratified by simple majority vote of SPARC Directors.
